THIS IS A CODICIL to the last Will and Testament of me SIR HALL CAINE of Groeba Castle Isle of Man C.H., K.B.E., which said Will is dated the Nineteenth day of August One thousand nine hundred and thirty WHEREAS by my said Will I have bequeathed to my daughter Elin a share in my residuary estate AND WHEREAS upon the marriage of my said daughter I have arranged to purchase for her at the price of One thousand and nine hundred pounds (£1,900) a dwelling house and premises in which it is intended she shall reside NOW I HEREBY DECLARE that my said daughter shall not take any share in my residuary estate without bringing the said sum of One thousand and nine hundred pounds into hotchpot and accounting for the same accordingly as if such sum had been paid to her at the vesting period defined in my Will on account of her share in such residuary estate IN all other respects I CONFIRM my said Will AS WITNESS my name hereunto subscribed this *Tenth* day of *November* One thousand nine hundred and thirty (1930)...
